## HOUSE OF COMMONS PAGE PROGRAM:

### Launch of the Annual Recruitment Campaign

Every year, House of Commons Pages are selected from high schools and CEGEPs across Canada to work in the House of Commons. While pursuing their studies at a university in the National Capital Region, these students gain valuable work experience and make friendships and memories that will last a lifetime.

Pages live and breathe the history and action of one of Canada's oldest political institutions and play a key role in the communications network within Parliament. Delivering important messages and

documents to Members, linking Members to their parliamentary offices and serving House officials in various capacities, Pages are always on the go. Providing professional, non-partisan, prompt and efficient service has become a hallmark of the House of Commons Page Program.

**This year's recruitment campaign launches October 2, 2017, with an application deadline of December 4, 2017. All applications must be submitted online through the Parliament of Canada website at [ourcommons.ca/page](http://ourcommons.ca/page).**



#### To apply, each candidate must:

- be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- be graduating from a secondary school or a CEGEP (with no academic interruptions) and beginning full-time university studies in September 2018;
- have an overall academic average of at least 80%;
- be able to communicate efficiently in both official languages, as evaluated by the House of Commons; and
- have accepted an admission offer from a university in the National Capital Region.

Selected candidates will be awarded a **one-year work contract to begin in late August 2018**. They will work a minimum of 15 hours a week and their work schedule will be coordinated with their university schedule.

Pages will receive an annual salary of \$16,088 paid in 26 equal payments. In addition, a sum of \$1,200 will be paid at the end of their employment period for successful completion of the contract.
