THE MANITOBA COUNCIL FOR EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN TRANSITION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility: There are two scholarships worth \$750.00 each available to a *student in Manitoba with exceptional needs who is transitioning from high school* to after school life, such as post-secondary education, job training or employment. The winning student must demonstrate a 'Yes I Can' attitude. The scholarship money is given directly to the student upon verification of graduation from high school.

RED RIVER VALLEY TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

The Red River Valley Teachers' Association Scholarship is designed to assist individuals entering post-secondary education or training programs. A maximum of four (4) scholarships of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) each may be offered to graduating students within the Red River Valley School Division.

Applicants must indicate their desire to work with students and youth. It is assumed that the applicant(s) will be pursuing their education immediately following their graduation from high school. **The scholarship money will be forwarded directly to the recipient after the Red River Valley Teachers' Association has received confirmation of post-secondary registration. The successful recipient shall provide required proof of post-secondary registration prior to August 31, 2018**

To be eligible for this scholarship you must supply the following:

- A. A completed scholarship application form. (included on page 5)
- B. A formal résumé.
- C. An official copy of your transcript.
- D. A completed declaration form (included on page 5)
- E. A personal essay – On a separate sheet of paper with your name at the top of the page, respond to the following question in a maximum of 500 words. Please use a word processed format for your response.
What contribution do you believe you can make in the life of a young person?
- F. 2 references – One (1) provided by either your school administrator or teacher and one (1) from a community member.

Additional Scholarship Information

1. The submission deadline for this package is on or before **February 12, 2018**. All documents must be post marked or received via email no later than this date. All forms must be in type written format or word-processed.
2. Essay responses must be completed as outlined and must be in double spaced format, and may be in either of Canada's two official languages.
3. Two (2) references are required and shall be returned with the application package.
 - a) The school reference must be from either the school administrator or a teacher and shall include an evaluation of applicant's academic achievements, motivation, potential, leadership, abilities, and peer interaction.

b) The community reference must be from a member of the community, not a teacher, who can address the applicant's community involvement, motivation, potential, leadership, abilities, and interaction with others.

4. A high school transcript must be included with the application package.
